This has reference to the attached DM-LA-2021-0114 dated 17 May 2021 relative to the Ramon Magsaysay Award Foundation's A NextGen Leadership Program.

This program provides mentorship opportunities for budding young leaders, 18 to 25 years old seeks to harness the NextGen leaders' creative energies to take on the challenges of the times with the hope that the participants will be able to adopt leadership gems from interacting with the roster of Ramon Magsaysay Awardees, Asia's transformative leaders. The program will run virtually from June 14 -25, 2021.

Qualifications for the NextGen Leadership Program are the following:

- a. Social change leaders working in Asia and for Asia;
- b. Ages 18-25 years old;
- c. Passionate, and in active search for greater meaning and growth in their journey as a young leader;
- d. Civic-minded and have shown interest in social advocacies;
- e. Involved in youth action;
- f. Connected with student organizations and peer groups;
- g. Holding a permanent position in DepEd;
- h. Rendered at least 2 years of service with DepEd;

- i. No pending administrative and/or criminal case;
- j. Did not go on habitual leave (max of 2 months/year), excluding maternity leave;
- k. Willing to sign service obligation of 6 months upon completion of program; and
- 1. In good health (no debilitating, chronic illnesses or serious health condition).

Interested nominees should secure the following:

- 1. Resume with birthyear information, affiliations on civic and youth action, and references from student organization/ peer groups
- 2. Letter request endorsed by the respective Head of Office
- 3. Accomplished Service Obligation Contract
- 4. Accomplished Form 6
- 5. Accomplished form 41
- 6. Accomplished form 212
- 7. Working laptop with strong, secured, and stable internet connection

In this program, scholars are expected to:

- Attend 12 days of intensive, intimate, and personal learning sessions with Ramon Magsaysay Awardees ;
- Network and engage with fellow youth leaders among various Asian countries;
- Receive grant money for the implementation of the 2021 cohort project, accessing the mentoring opportunities of respected business and civil leaders;
- Receive the RMTLI NextGen Leadership Program Certificate of Participation upon completion;
- Experience Career development opportunities with notable industry leaders (post-session);
- Perform batch project planning, implementation, monitoring, and assessment; and
- Participate in Alumnae fellowship sessions.
