This pertains to the celebration of the **16**th **National Biotechnology Week (NBW)** on November 23-27, 2020 with the theme **BIOTEKNOLOHIYA: Pagbangon at Pag-Asa Tungo sa Matatag na Komunidad, Kapaligiran, at Ekonomiya.** The celebration is pursuant to Presidential Proclamation No. 14114, which declares the observance of every last week of November as the National Biotechnology Week.
