In relation to OUA-MEMO-00-0122-0014 "Guidelines on Monitoring And Reporting of Psychological First Aid Provision to Learners and Personnel Affected by Typhoon Odette, the Bureau of Learner Support Services-Youth Formation Division (BLSS-YFD) reiterates the following roles and responsibilities of Regional ad Division Youth Formation Coordinators in response to the onslaught of Typhoon (TY) Odette:

- 1. Close coordination with the DRRM Coordinators and School Health Personnel for the provision of technical support in conducting virtual or face-to-face Psychological First Aid to learners and personnel including the reporting of concluded provisions.
- 2. Mobilize the Regional and Division Federation of Student Government Officers, both SPG and SSG, to conduct debriefing or stress reliever activities for affected learners.
- 3. Support the donation drive and relief operation for TY Odette in coordination with Social Mobilization Unit.

With this, the BLSS-YFD requests the full support of Youth Formation Coordinators to the TY Odette response of the department.
